X. DISTRICT STAFF ITEMS

- A. Chief William Steenbergh
 - 1. Discussed the current status of COVID-19 that included staff and operational changes; some members testing positive but recovered and are back to work; some self quarantining due to exposure on calls or family exposures; supplies being a challenge; continuing to work with the County and State to obtain supplies; staff researching online for new vendors; will continue to purchase items to remain operational; no timeline yet on FEMA reimbursement, its opened ended at this point; internally categorizing COVID-19 expenditures.
- B. Assistant Chief Eric Philipp
 - 1. Chimney fire on March 21st in Kingwood Park; thanked the crews who did a great job especially during this time.

C. Director of EMS David Violante

1. Thanked the crews and knows they are under a ton of stress.

Thanked Chief Steenbergh and the BOFC for being very supportive and how we are doing things. Continues to have conference calls with the NYS Department of Health, Region and following up with the DC Department of Public Health and local hospitals. State has put out certifications updates for everyone to remain certified. Following CDC and State guidelines for PPE; continues to monitor this and we respond accordingly.

D. Treasurer James Passikoff

1. Chairman Chiumento acknowledged receipt of the Treasurer's February 2020 monthly Financial Report for the District. No March bank statements yet; Chief Steenbergh asked him to have a separate line in the financial report for COVID-19 expenses on page 8 under "fire operations".
