- 4. Briefly updated the BOFC re: COVID-19. Have received monetary (Friendly Ford), material and food donations; thank you letters have been going out and gives public recognition on our Facebook page. Participating in birthday drive-bys; average 3-4 a day. Response numbers are dropping; went from 13% in the beginning to 26% in April and now single digits so far; outside training starting this week with the probationary firefighters; will keep an eye on the numbers and if everything is good, will begin hands on training with the on duty crew next week; the guys should be commended for their hard work in keeping everyone healthy from situational awareness, wearing the gear properly, decontaminating themselves and equipment, disinfecting the stations; waiting to hear about the fire academy, still have probationary firefighters that need to attend.
- 5. Received a denial letter for turnout gear washing machine grant. Will have to look at this in the future, still not working properly.
