I. PROPOSED RULES & REGULATIONS

The Board of Fire Commissioners reviewed the proposed Rules and Regulations and some highlights include:

PREFACE - DC Pells stated that OSHA sited that Arlington does not have an organizational statement.

Comm. Chiumento stated that he does not agree with the following statement:

"....Arlington Fire District has the responsibility of the people within the fire district to provide them with quality trained professional personnel with the expertise to mitigate any emergencies that may arise."

Comm. Chiumento's concern was that we do not have the expertise to mitigate ANY

emergency. We have the expertise for fire and EMS emergencies. "ANY" may imply other situations i.e. confined space.

Comm. Philipp stated that it should read "any fire or EMS emergencies that may arise".

SECTION 1 - CHIEF ENGINEER

Comm. Richardson stated that "living in the District" should be added. DC Pells stated that a lot of adjustments were made for Training 2000.

Discussion of what it should read for courses required. Comm. Chiumento stated that he wants to eliminate duplication.

ASSISTANT CHIEFS

Comm. Chiumento stated that he thought it was also if they left office. Discussion.
