X. **DISTRICT STAFF ITEMS**

- A. Chief William Steenbergh
1. NYSHIP rates for 2022 were posted – individual plan increased 10.1% and family plans increased by 11.4%. We budgeted for 11%.
 2. Requesting the BOFC to surplus old, outdated fire nozzles, fittings, etc. to be donated to the DC Fire Training Center for use in firefighter training by the County.

A motion was made by Comm. Griffing to donate any surplus equipment that the Chief deemed non usable to the County Training Center. Seconded by Comm. Dore.

- B. Assistant Chief Eric Philipp – No report.

C. Director of EMS David Violante

1. We are no longer able to purchase regular pharmaceuticals from Mid-Hudson Regional Hospital. We continue to have a good relationship with them and still use them under contract for our Controlled Substances.

There will be a significant increase in pharmaceutical costs that could be upwards of \$15,000.00, which we will have to absorb this next year and then budget for these items in next year's planning.

We have a few local suppliers we can use in the short-term and have signed on with National Cooperative Purchasing Agents to purchase at better pricing in the long term. We are also working to determine NYS Bid pricing.

We will continue to evaluate the system and make it as efficient as possible while still meeting the formulary required in the protocols, and will keep the Board updated as we move forward.

2. COVID boosters are available.
3. Working with Pharmacist at Walgreen's to offer flu vaccines to our members.
4. Has one (1) item for Executive Session as noted on the agenda, but will include it with the Chief's item. (*Chief originally had one item, but added two items as noted in the minutes below*)

D. Treasurer James Passikoff

1. Chairman Chiumento to acknowledge receipt of the Treasurer's October 31, 2021 Financial Report for the District.
2. Will be requesting Board authorization on the next meeting agenda in December to pay the NYS Retirement bills prior to December 15th to receive a substantial discount.
