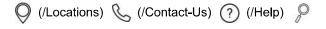

# Investment Update

### NASDAQ and S&P 500 Hit Record Highs

The tech-heavy NASDAQ index hit its first record high since November 2021 yesterday, closing at 16,091. The index finally recovered all its losses from the 2022 bear market, where it lost 33 percent of its value. That said, the NASDAQ is up more than 75 percent since the beginning of 2020, by far the best performance of the major indexes. The NASDAQ is up 7.2 percent this year.

The broad market S&P 500 also hit a record high yesterday, ending at 5,096. The S&P reached its first record high in nearly two years in December and has hit 14 new record highs this year. The index is up 6.8 percent year-to-date. It is essentially the same story for the Dow Jones Industrial Average, which closed at 38,996 yesterday. The Dow hit 30,000 only a little over three years ago.

The 2022 bear market, when the S&P 500 was down more than 18 percent, was painful. However, the three-year annualized average return for the S&P 500 is 11.7 percent, which includes 2022. The five-year annualized average return is even better at 14.6 percent. This period not only includes the bear market in 2022, but also the COVID-19 pandemic-related sell-off of early 2020.

There will be bad years in the future, and they are never fun, but having an allocation to equities remains one of the best ways to grow wealth over the long term.

### PCE Continues to Show Improvement

The Personal Consumption Expenditure (PCE) Deflator Index, the Federal Reserve's preferred measure of inflation, came in at 2.4 percent for January. The index is nearing the Fed's 2 percent inflation target and has been consistently trending down since peaking at 7.1 percent in June 2022. As mentioned in our last update, the Consumer Price Index and the Producer Price Index, both important inflation data points, came in a little hotter than expected. Yesterday's PCE release came in as expected and provided a boost to markets.

## **Nvidia Still Surging**

Nvidia released quarterly earnings last Wednesday which confirmed they are one of the biggest winners of the artificial intelligence (AI) boom. Demand for their specialized, powerful and expensive semiconductors, which are used for training popular AI services like ChatGPT and OpenAI, has surged over the last 18 months. This has led to the company's meteoric stock price rise. Nvidia's stock is up 62 percent already this year, building on last year's 239 percent rise.

The company's revenue in its fiscal fourth quarter more than tripled from a year earlier to \$22.1 billion, while profit soared nearly ninefold to \$12.3 billion. Revenue was well above the \$20 billion the company predicted in November, easily surpassing Wall Street estimates of \$20.4 billion. We continue to view AI as one of the secular forces that will help drive markets for the foreseeable future.

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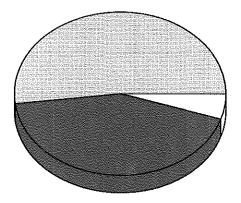

**Proposed AFDSNY Bylaw Amendments**

Proposed amendments to the Bylaws of the Association of Fire Districts of the State of New York will be presented for approval during the business session at the 80th Annual Meeting. This event is scheduled to take place on Monday, October 21, 2024, at the Turning Stone Resort and Casino in Verona, New York.

The Board of Directors collectively submitted the proposed amendments during its Quarterly meeting in September 2023. The initial signed amendment was officially filed with Catherine Thompson, serving as the Chairperson of the Administration Committee. Copies of the proposal were also provided to the President and the Secretary/Treasurer of the Association on September 29, 2023. Both Ms. Thompson and Ms. Schields confirmed receipt on October 5, 2023.

At its Quarterly Meeting held via Zoom on January 20, 2024, Ms. Thompson, in her capacity as Chairperson of the Administration Committee, introduced the proposed amendment to the Board of Directors.

# Fire Service Reacting to OSHA Plan to Replace Existing Fire Brigade Standard with Broader Guidelines

On December 21, 2023, the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) unveiled a proposal to create a new Emergency Response Rule to replace the current fire brigade standard. The new rule would expand requirements on fire personnel, fire departments and entities that operate fire departments. It would also add rules to cover emergency medical personnel and search-and-rescue workers. It appears the objective is to bring rules on emergency workers, a variety of workplace hazards, including exposure to toxic chemicals, equipment failures, infectious diseases, and the mental health impact of first-responder positions all within a unified framework.

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Fire Service Associations
Meet and Issu Legislative
Plans for 2024

A meeting held on December 2, 2023, in Troy, New York, addressed legislative priorities for the state fire service associations in 2024. Representatives from FASNY, the Association of Fire Districts of the State of New York, the New York State Association of Fire Chiefs, the Volunteer Fire Police Association of the State of New York, the County Fire Coordinators' Association, and the New York State Fire Marshals and Inspectors Association were in attendance. The agreed-upon legislative agenda, traditionally termed the "Issues of United Concern," serves as a collective focus for advocacy efforts, allowing each association to endorse these items as a unified voice.

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### IRS Issues Standard Mileage Rates for 2024

The Internal Revenue Service has announced the mileage rate for 2024 that employees can be reimbursed for use of their personal vehicle during a job assignment. The rate has been increased to sixty-seven (67) cents per mile.

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### **Annual Financial Report of the Fire District**

The fire district fiscal year runs from January 1st through December 31st each year. At its annual organization meeting the Board of Fire Commissioners will adopt a motion to provide the Treasurer with 60 days from January 1st to file the Annual Financial Report for the just completed fiscal year.

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IRS Issues Standard Milage Rates for 2024

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### **Fire District and Fire Company External Audits**

It is generally considered the best financial practice for local governmental entities and not for profit corporations to have an external audit performed by an independent accounting firm or certified public accountant at the close of each fiscal year. In New York State fire districts with annual revenues of \$400,000.00 or more [Town Law § 181-b] and fire companies with revenues of

\$400,000.00 or more that contract with a city, town, village, or fire district to provide fire service [General Municipal Law §209-z] are required by statute to have an annual external audit performed. General Municipal Law §209-z also empowers the State Comptroller to set a lesser threshold for fire companies, but he has not done so.

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### The Permissive Referendum Process to Sell or Dispose of Property or Equipment

A Board of Fire Commissioners is permitted to sell or dispose of property of the fire district which is no longer necessary for the uses and purposes of the fire district.

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### Officers and Employees' Disclosures of Potential Conflict of Interest- When and How?

Officers and employees within fire districts are obligated to adhere to the provisions outlined in Article 18 of the General Municipal Law regarding potential conflicts of interest. This article delineates the circumstances under which officers and employees must divulge potential conflicts and outlines the prescribed methods for making such disclosures. Additionally, Article 18 mandates that every fire district must establish a written code of ethics, which may further specify criteria for defining interests and stipulate additional conditions for mandatory disclosures.

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### The Need for Innovative Training Approaches to Cultivate a Better Workplace Culture

Over the years, we have imposed additional mandates on both public and private workplaces to eradicate discrimination, workplace violence, and various manifestations of antisocial behavior. Adapting to evolving laws, regulations, and societal shifts poses a constant challenge for all workplaces. The transformations within our workplaces often mirror broader societal changes external to them. Adapting to these changes is a complex task, and overlooking them can pose risks.

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# A Different Freedom of Expression: The Right of Nursing Employees to Express Breast Milk in the Workplace

In December of 2022 the Governor signed Chapter 672 of the Law of 2022 into law amended Labor Law §206-c on protection afforded to mothers with a need to express breast milk during working hours. The amendments were effective on June 7, 2023.

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### **AFDSNY 2024 Mini Summits in Westchester & Erie Counties**

In 2024, the Board of Directors has chosen to fill the gap created by shifting our Annual Meeting and Vendor Expo to October. This will be achieved by organizing a Mini Summit in both Westchester and Erie Counties in April and May.

Commissioner Training will be offered on Thursday April 25th and other classes for commissioners and other fire district officers on April 26th and April 27th.

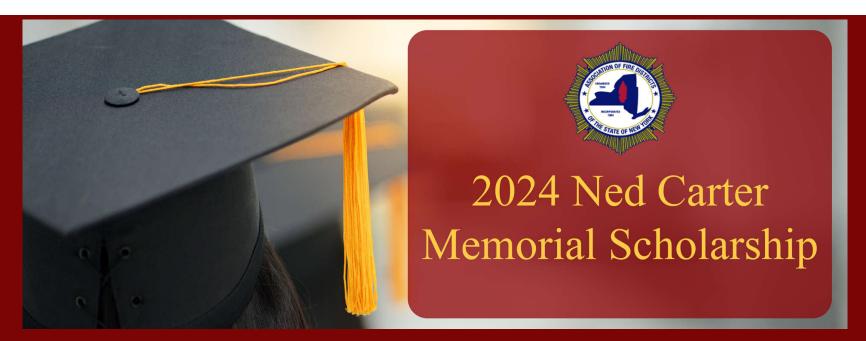
#### **AFDSNY FIRE COMMISSIONER TRAINING FOR 2024**
