BOARD OF FIRE COMMISSIONERS MEETING MINUTES March 16, 2026

2. Thanks to the Union and lobbying, Rochdale received \$1 million appropriation through Congressman Ryan to address structural issues at Rochdale. Will be looking at what needs to be done, discussing with architects and doing proper planning. Will be starting soon.
