A. Chief Adam Kangas

1. Offered to speak to David Wexler (who made public comments at the beginning of the meeting) after the meeting. Chief is aware of the situation and can't speak of it publicly due to pending litigation but would like to have a conversation with him. Mr. Wexler agreed.
2. Gas conversion proposal for HQ – Central Hudson did an assessment to convert HQ to gas. Would be a total of a 300-foot run. The first 100 feet, Central Hudson would take care of and 200 feet we would be responsible for at a cost of \$28,500. This is the cost to install just the gas lines. There are positives to this as our oil tank is getting old and not efficient; it would cost less to run, gas is cheaper; maintenance would be less as well as operations. Leaving this up to the Board to decide.

No action taken by the Board; will need to discuss further.

3. Personnel Administrator approval for title change. New title will be Director of Personnel and Business Administration. (Title Change Only - No changes to existing contract); solicited DC Civil Service for new title to align with what Heather does – not only HR, but also day to day business administration.

Comm. Chiumento made a motion to approve the change in title from Personnel Administrator to Director of Personnel and Business Administration with no other changes to existing contract. Seconded by Comm. Jackson.
